Our annual baseball game is scheduled for Sunday August 1st at 8:00 pm. This will take place at the Cloyne Ball Diamond.

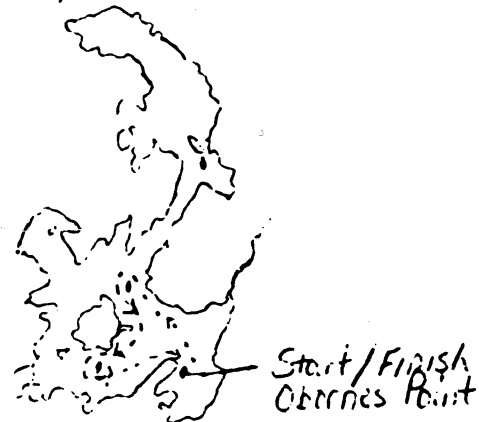
LET'S GO FISHING

Sunday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm


ONTARIO WILDLIFE HOTLINES!
